

SUNDERLAND CITY COUNCIL (ADVANCE VOTING AND SIGNING FOR BALLOT PAPERS) PILOT (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2007

Made 1st May 2007

Coming into force in accordance with Article 1

This Order is made in exercise of the powers conferred by section 10(1) of the Representation of the People Act 2000(a).

Sunderland City Council submitted proposals for a scheme under section 10 of the 2000 Act to apply to any election that will take place in relation to any vacancy in the membership of the City Council, and any election to a Parish Council with which that election will be combined, arising on the ordinary date for elections in 2007.

The Secretary of State modified the City Council's proposals and consulted the City Council on the modifications, as he is required to under section 10 of the 2000 Act. The Secretary of State also consulted the Electoral Commission on these proposals, as he is required to under section 10(1A) of the 2000 Act(b).

Accordingly, the Secretary of State makes the following Order:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. This Order may be cited as the Sunderland City Council (Advance Voting and Signing for Ballot Papers) Pilot (Amendment) Order 2007 and shall come into force forthwith.

2.—(1) In this Order “the Principal Order” means the Sunderland City Council (Advance Voting and Signing for Ballot Papers) Pilot Order 2007.

(2) Any expression used both in this Order and in the Principal Order has the same meaning in this Order as it has in the Principal Order.

Amendment to the Principal Order

3. In rule 35(1) of Schedule 1 to the Principal Order (The Principal Areas – Advance Voting and Signing for Ballot Papers Pilot – Rules), delete the words “if he is applying at an advance voting station,”.

4. In rule 35(1) of Schedule 2 to the Principal Order (The Parishes – Advance Voting and Signing for Ballot Papers Pilot – Rules), delete the words “if he is applying at an advance voting station,”.
